#### Re: Infringement of Dow Jones's Copyrighted News Articles

Dear Mr. Jacobs:

We are litigation counsel for Dow Jones, which owns and operates The Wall Street Journal, Barron's, Dow Jones Newswires, MarketWatch and other publications including those listed in Schedule A. Our client is deeply concerned that CALPERS appears to have been committing pervasive and willful infringement of Dow Jones's copyrights in its publications (collectively, "Dow Jones Content").

We have learned that CALPERS has displayed on a public-facing website at www.calpers.ca.gov/apps/news/default.asp numerous full-text articles reproduced from the Journal and other Dow Jones publications. We understand, for example, that approximately 9,000 Journal articles and 250 Barron's articles, dated from 2009 to the recent past, were reproduced and displayed. The articles represent a selection of the content of the Journal and other publications that was evidently curated by someone acting on behalf of CALPERS, and therefore the dissemination of these articles must have been intentional. The CALPERScontrolled URL at which this content was made available has only been taken down within the last few days.

These acts, unless licensed by Dow Jones, are violations of Dow Jones's rights under the Copyright Act of 1976, including Dow Jones's exclusive rights of reproduction, see 17 U.S.C. § 106(1), distribution, id. § 106(3), and public display, id. § 106(5), and analogous provisions of non-U.S. law. In addition, by inducing viewers to further disseminate Journal articles without Dow Jones's authorization, CALPERS would be liable for contributory copyright infringement and/or inducement to infringement. See Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Studios Inc. v. Grokster, Ltd., 545 U.S. 913, 934-37 (2005). You should be aware that Dow Jones consistently and rigorously enforces its intellectual property rights. See, e.g., Dow Jones & Company v. Real-Time News & Analysis, Ltd., 14-Civ-131 (S.D.N.Y. 2014); Press Release, Dow Jones & Company, Dow Jones Successfully Resolves Major Copyright Infringement Claim,

(June 12, 2012); Jonathan Stempel, Dow Jones, Briefing.com Settle 'Hot News' Lawsuit, Reuters (Nov. 16, 2010).

CALPERS's apparent copyright infringement would entitle Dow Jones to substantial damages under U.S. law, including, at Dow Jones's election, (a) CALPERS's profits and Dow Jones's actual damages, or (b) statutory damages of \$750-\$30,000 per work infringed, increased to up to \$150,000 per work infringed if the infringement was willful, as CALPERS's infringement appears to have been. *See* 17 U.S.C. § 504(a)-(c). CALPERS's infringement would also entitle Dow Jones to recover its attorney's fees and costs of suit. *See* 17 U.S.C. § 505.<sup>1</sup>

In addition, CALPERS's reproduction and display of Dow Jones Content stripped the copyright notice from each article. Under the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (codified within Title 17), Dow Jones is entitled to statutory damages of up to \$25,000 and attorney's fees for each act of stripping such "copyright management information" from the copyrighted work. Id. § 1203(c)(3).

If CALPERS believes it has been licensed by Dow Jones to reproduce Dow Jones Content as described above, we demand to know the basis for such claim. If not, we hereby demand that CALPERS immediately cease and desist from all unauthorized uses of the copyrighted material in Dow Jones's publications and services. We also demand that CALPERS immediately remove all Dow Jones Content from all computer systems, web sites and other facilities within its control, and direct all to whom Dow Jones Content has been made available by CALPERS, to remove such content from their systems and files. We also demand that CALPERS immediately take appropriate affirmative steps to preserve, and to cause its agents to preserve, all electronic and paper documents that relate to CALPERS's reproduction and display of Dow Jones Content.

Furthermore, to assist in determining the harm that has been done by the aforementioned activities of CALPERS, we demand that, within ten days, CALPERS produce to us the following information, including documentation sufficient to evidence the accuracy and completeness of CALPERS's responses:

- (1) confirmation that CALPERS has complied and will continue to comply with the preceding demands;
- (2) a complete description of how it came about that CALPERS reproduced and made Dow Jones Content available;
- (3) a complete description of all web addresses, platforms, services, devices and methods by which CALPERS made available Dow Jones Content;

- (4) a complete description of the time period within which CALPERS has disseminated Dow Jones Content;
- (5) a complete description of the universe of persons to whom CALPERS has made available Dow Jones Content;
- (6) a complete description of the users who accessed Dow Jones Content made available by CALPERS, including the number of such users and their location;
- a complete description of any restrictions regarding use or further distribution that CALPERS purported to apply to its dissemination of Dow Jones Content;
- (8) the title and publication date of each article of Dow Jones Content that CALPERS has made available via any website or other platform or service provided by CALPERS; and
- (9) the identity of each individual or entity employed by or otherwise acting on behalf of CALPERS who was involved in the selection and dissemination by CALPERS of any Dow Jones Content, including that person's title, position or relationship to CALPERS and full contact information.

Upon receipt of this information, we will be in a position to determine the amount of compensation that is required for CALPERS's extensive – and apparently unauthorized – use of Dow Jones's copyrighted content. If no response is received within ten days, Dow Jones is fully prepared to pursue all available remedies at law and equity. This letter does not purport to be a complete statement of the relevant facts or law, and is without prejudice to Dow Jones's legal and equitable rights, all of which are expressly reserved.
